Manure Happens – Cluster Analysis

Narcy's Manufactured Chaos → Heroic Cleanup Cycle

PHASE 1 — MANUFACTURED CHAOS

- Narcy creates or escalates a problem that did not need to exist.
- The mess becomes the stage for a future performance.
- Others feel confused or responsible, despite not causing the issue.
- Chaos sets the hook for her next move: the heroic entry.

PHASE 2 — PERFORMANCE-BASED HELP

- Narcy returns dramatically to 'fix' the mess she caused.
- Her assistance is exaggerated, theatrical, and self-congratulatory.
- She positions herself as the only competent or caring one.
- The help is not about solving the issue it's about being seen helping.

PHASE 3 — IMAGE REINFORCEMENT

- She amplifies how helpful, thoughtful, or essential she was.
- The narrative becomes about her goodness rather than the original chaos.
- This phase rewrites memory: the crisis fades, her image grows.
- This is textbook impression management and image crafting.

PHASE 4 — ADMIRATION HARVEST

- Narcy expects appreciation, validation, and praise for her efforts.
- The cleanup becomes her evidence of being the hero of the moment.
- Accountability disappears she is now the rescuer, not the instigator.
- Pattern resets: she will create another mess when she needs more supply.
